

Honor Code Appeals Process—Alleged Violation of Non-Academic Misconduct

Grounds for appeal:

decision final

- Conduct Coordinator or Hearing Panel failed to follow procedures of the Honor Code
- Discipline ordered by the Panel is materially disproportionate to the severity of the violation
- New & compelling evidence has been discovered that was not available during original review

Student files "Notice of Appeal" to the Student Conduct Coordinator within 5 working days after receiving notice of final determination of the Hearing Panel Appeal Panel organized & includes 2 students & 1 staff member Appeal Panel receives the following: All information provided to the Hearing Panel Written decision of the Hearing Panel Completed Notice of Appeal Appeal Panel may do one of the following: Affirm decision in its totality Affirm decision as to responsibility, but modify discipline Reverse decision & order new panel to conduct new hearing Reverse decision & dismiss alleged violation Appeal Panel Decision by majority vote Request to review the matter internally Appeal Panel or by Provost/VP for Student Affairs &
