Corporate and Transactional Law General Course Guide

Corporate lawyers advise businesses such as partnerships, publicly and privately held companies, and business start-ups, concerning their legal rights and obligations in transactional, regulatory, and litigation-related matters. General corporate practice involves handling a wide range of legal and business issues, including contract negotiation and dealmaking, mergers and acquisitions, labor and employment issues, real estate and intellectual property issues, and liability and insurance issues.

In addition to required courses (*e.g.*, Contracts, Property, Business Organizations, and Secured Transactions), students interested in becoming corporate lawyers should take relevant elective courses. Depending on their area of interest, students should also review the courses listed under the Tax Law track.¹
