Students minoring in Health Informatics and Analytics should work with the SPH advisor to make up the 1 credit needed that is typically completed the spring of \*\*\*Internship requires coordination with Program Director. Six credit hours of HCAD 421 are required to graduate. Students can take HCAD 421 beginning the summer after their junior year. Only three credit hours of HCAD 421 may be taken in any given semester. \*\*\*\*Capstone must be taken spring of senior year.
