Desired Course Load

- 128 credits (hours) required for graduation
- Average load = 16 credits per semester
- 16 credits x 8 semesters = 128 credits
- Full time/Flat Rate tuition 12-18 credits

- ACT Reading and English of 28+ (may be on multiple exams)
- SAT score of 33 in either Reading or Writing and Language
- Transfer credit
- AP Score of 4 or 5 (4 hours credit)
- Dual Enrollment Credit

Math	1 course/4 credits
Social Science	1 course/4 credits
Humanities	1 course/4 credits
Arts in Society	1 course/3 credits
World and Classical Languages and Cultures	4-16 credits depending on initial placement (must take 1 course 202 or higher)
