Attrition:

Of the 16 Samford University freshmen students who declared Interior Design as a in 2017, 15 returned in fall of 2018 resulting in an attrition rate of only **6.25%** in the major.

Graduation Rates:

Of the 22 students graduating in 2018 and 2019, **91%** graduated in 4 years with only 9% completing graduation requirements in 4+ years.

Of interior Design graduates who have applied to graduate studies in the last 5-year history of the program (2013-2018), **100%** have been accepted.

Of the 35 Interior Design graduates in the last 5-year history of the program (2013-2018), who did not immediately enrolled in Graduate Studies, **86%** secured job placement in the design industry.

Of the 43 total Interior Design graduates in the last 5-year history of the program (2013-2018), **89%** either enrolled in graduate school or secured job placement in the design industry.
