The institute fulfills its mission by focusing its work on five key areas:

Peer groups—Peer groups are locally led and meet regularly to share in learning, formation and practice of preaching. These groups are supported with resources and training by the institute. The goal is to establish peer groups nationwide.

Conferences—The institute offers conferences with nationally recognized speakers and preachers, and which will provide time for worship, fellowship and learning.

Events—The institute hosts one-day events on Beeson's campus in order to provide ongoing education for preachers. Events include conversations with Beeson professors and From Text to Sermon workshops.

Sabbatical and retreats—The institute offers two opportunities that offers one's spiritual well-being and formation: spiritual retreats for groups and one- to two-week sabbaticals for individuals on the campus of Samford University.

Resources—The institute provides online resources, such as videos, podcasts and articles, to help strengthen the quality of preaching.
