

Bankruptcy Course Pre-requisite / Co-requisite Waiver Form

To register for Bankruptcy (Law 608) at Cumberland School of Law, students must have successfully completed Secured Transactions (Law 533) or be registered for Secured Transactions for the same semester in which the student registers for Bankruptcy.

In appropriate circumstances a student may register for Bankruptcy without having completed or being registered for Secured Transactions PROVIDED the professor gives his/her approval. Because Bankruptcy assumes knowledge of Secured Transactions, students who take Bankruptcy without the required co-requisite may be at a disadvantage.

In order to register for Bankruptcy without having completed or being registered for Secured Transactions, a student must:

- (1) sign the form, acknowledging that he/she understands the warning set forth above;
- (2) have the professor sign the form indicating the professor's approval; and
- (3) submit the completed form to the Office of Law Student Records.
