Spring 2018 Exams

Law School exams are scheduled for April 24 – May 9. Following are a few important tips/reminders:

ALTERNATES:

 Students must gain permission from the professor no later than <u>noon on the last day of classes</u>
Tuesday, April 24) if they plan to take an exam at an alternate time.

(2) The professor is responsible for the submission of an alternate exam envelope to Mrs. Zimmer. Students may not turn in their names or an alternate exam envelope to Mrs. Zimmer.

(3) A list of all alternate exam envelope submissions will be posted on the bulletin board outside the Associate Dean's office on Wednesday, April 25. Students must check the list for their name and information. If permission has been granted from the professor for an alternate but the student's name does not appear on the list, the student must contact the professor.

COMPUTER SOFTWARE:

(1) Students must download the new version of the Exam4 software at http://exam4.com/. The new version will be available on Monday, April 16. <u>ALL PREVIOUS VERSIONS HAVE EXPIRED</u>, including the midterm version. Complete download instructions are on the Cumberland website at https:// www.samford.edu/cumberlandlaw/files/Extegrity_ Instructions.pdf.

(2) <u>THE NEW COMPUTER EXAM SOFTWARE IS</u> <u>AVAILABLE FOR DOWNLOAD NOW THROUGH</u> <u>APRIL 28, AFTER WHICH DOWNLOADS WILL</u> <u>BE UNAVAILABLE.</u> If students plan to take exams via computer, students must download within this window.

(3) Students should complete practice test(s) (choosing the "<u>S18 Practice Exam</u>" option from the course dropdown box). Submit the practice tests wirelessly.

(4) Students should notify Jeff Whitcomb(jmwhitco@samford.edu) prior to the beginning of the exam period regarding technology issues.

EXAM SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURES – STUDENTS SHOULD:

 Check the exam schedule at https://www. samford.edu/cumberlandlaw/files/2018_spring_ exam_schedule.pdf and arrive at the exam on the correct date and at the appropriate time.

(2) Arrive in their scheduled room fifteen minutes prior to the start of any exam.

(3) Bring to the exam room writing utensils, ear plugs and any materials the professor allows. Proctors will supply bluebooks (for handwriters) and scratch paper. Earplugs or earphones that have the CAPABILITY of playing anything in the ear are disallowed.
