## Statement of Understanding and Requirements

I, the undersigned, agree to the following terms and conditions as a representative of the Miss Samford University title:

# I. General Conduct and Representation

- O I understand that, if selected as Miss Samford University, my conduct must reflect high moral standards and I must serve as an appropriate role model.
- o I agree to represent the title, the competition, and its committee with professionalism, honor, integrity, and dignity always.
- O I acknowledge that I am always "Miss Samford University" and will maintain a well groomed, professional appearance in public.

# II. Appearances and Public Engagements

- All appearances as Miss Samford University must be approved by the Director(s).
  \*This includes requests from civic groups, school organizations, other competition directors, and media (print or electronic).\*
- o All media inquiries must be forwarded to the Co-Director(s).

#### I will:

- o Dress appropriately and professionally at all events.
- o Ensure no tattoos or visible body piercings (other than earrings) are visible.
- o Be properly groomed (make-up, clothing, hair, and nails).

#### Lunderstand:

- o I am responsible for my own transportation to and from events.
- o If I have a boyfriend during my reign, he may not accompany me to appearances or show public displays of affection while I am in crown or representing my title.

### I agree to:

- o Be prompt, arriving at least 15 minutes prior to scheduled events.
- o Display enthusiasm and appreciation to event hosts and sponsors.
- o Send handwritten thank-you notes within 24 hours of any appearance.

#### I will not:

- o Smoke or consume alcoholic beverages at public events.
- o Be photographed with alcohol or tobacco.
- Wear inappropriate clothing or frequent establishments that suggest poor moral judgment.

### III. Required Appearances

I understand the following events are mandatory and must be prioritized on my calendar:

- o Miss Alabama Competition Candidate Workshop
- o Miss Alabama's Teen Competition & Candidate Introductions
- o Miss Samford University Send-Off Reception
- o Miss Alabama Gala & Candidate Introductions
- o Miss Alabama Top Ten Fashion Show (if applicable)
- o Speaking engagements
- Platform appearances

Excuses from required appearances must be approved by the Co-Director(s).

Sponsors: I understand that in addition to mailing hand-written thank you notes to sponsors, I will visit each sponsor in order to take photos and post to social media.

### V. Miss Alabama Competition Preparation

- o Maintain my best physical appearance through exercise and diet.
- o Stay informed on current events and news topics.
- o Participate in all prep sessions:
- Mock interviews
- Platform development
- Talent rehearsals
- On-stage practice
- o Practice my talent regularly and be prepared to perform at appearances.

### Wardrobe & Talent Approval

- o All wardrobe selections, photos, and talent must be approved at least two weeks prior to the Miss Alabama Workshop.
- Once approved, no substitutions or changes may be made without written approval from the Co-Director(s)
- o Clothing approval requires in-person presentation; photos or videos are not acceptable.
- o Provide my own wardrobe for all appearances and phases of competition.
- Work diligently on my platform and complete my Community Service Scrapbook at least one week before the Miss Alabama deadline.
- o Outside coaching is prohibited without Co-Director approval.
- o Parents and friends may support but may not participate in decision-making.
- o Talent-specific instruction (music, dance, etc.) is permitted.

#### VI. Paperwork & Approvals

It is my responsibility to:

- Obtain all necessary approvals and signatures from the Co-Director(s) prior to Miss Alabama deadlines.
- Schedule any required meetings to ensure compliance with timelines and competition rules.

#### VII. Succession Clause

- If I am crowned Miss Alabama, no successor will be named for Miss Samford University
- o If I resign prior to appearing in the Miss Alabama Competition, I will forfeit all scholarship winnings associated with the Miss Samford University title.

If I am in violation of this contract, I will forfeit all scholarship earnings, and otherwise, my title will be removed.
