

Employment Rates (Measure 7)

Samford University School of Education independently tracks the employment of program completers. Candidates are surveyed two weeks prior to graduation and asked for employment offers they have received. If not employed upon graduation, we continue to survey completers at different intervals until exhausting all efforts. From these records, the school is able to determine which graduates have secured teaching and leadership positions and report percentages as appropriate. The first chart below contains information about academic year 2018/2019 for our Initial Program completers. These graduates obtained their first teaching license. The second chart contains information about our 2018/2019 Advanced Program completers. Advanced completers are P-12 teachers or currently licensed administrators, or other certificated school professionals who are preparing for employment in P-12 schools/districts.
