This full-time program is designed for individuals who have earned a Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science, but desire to be a certified elementary school teacher. In addition to the ability to earn a master's degree in just one year, candidates will have the opportunity for extensive field experience and practical content application. This fast-track program places a heavy emphasis on clinical experiences and teaching pedagogy.

M.S.E. in Elementary Education

The Master of Science in Elementary Education with Class A certification is a 30-credit hour online program designed for those who have completed a bachelor's degree in early childhood/elementary education or elementary education and desire to gain knowledge and understanding of pedagogical concepts to impact their practice, the practice of others and learners in the K-6 classroom.

Online courses offer the same quality education as candidates receive in the classroom, but with the flexibility to work around your schedule. In this program, candidates will build strong relationships with classmates and our award-winning faculty in a small cohort setting.

M.S.E. in Gifted Education Preparing teachers to become certified gifted specialists (grades P-12)

This 30-credit hour online/blended program is designed to help teachers understand the unique characteristics of gifted, creative and talented students. Candidates will explore tools that can help gifted students stay engaged and motivated, learn to respond appropriately to the social and intellectual diversity of gifted learners, and provide curriculum and programs that develop talent and enhance critical thinking. Graduates will leave with enhanced teaching skills and will be prepared to empower gifted students through dynamic curriculum that fits their needs.

M.S.E. in Instructional Design and Technology

The master's degree in instructional design and technology is a 30-credit-hour program designed for candidates interested in leading the process by which curriculum and training is developed, implemented and evaluated. Candidates master the skills needed to deliver course work and training in blended and online formats within the fields of education, business, government and health care.

Graduates leave with a Class A certification and certified to work as a K-12 special education educator.

M.S.E. in Instructional Leadership

The 30-credit hour master's degree program in instructional leadership is designed for teachers with a passion for K-12 education and an unwavering belief in the importance of leadership development. Eligible candidates must hold a Bachelor of Science, Class B certification in education and have completed three years of successful teaching.

- Master's degree and eligible for certification in 18 months
- 10-day internship residency
- 80% of course work directed toward improving instructional practice in schools

Instructional leadership certification provides candidates with the required credentials to be considered for leadership positions in K-12 schools/systems in Alabama.*

*18-hour certification in instructional leadership eligibility available for candidates holding a master's degree in a teaching field from an accredited college/ university and a Class A certificate from the Alabama State Department of Education

M.S.E. in Educational Leadership: Policy, Organizations and Leadership

This program is designed for professionals interested in working with K-12 educational systems, higher education or nonprofit organizations working to make a difference in schooling. It serves to give a broad insight into the processes and moving parts of a school system—including policy, advocacy and program development. The 30-credit hour program also provides a look into how cultural factors shape student learning. Program instructors believe leadership communication is most effective when those in leadership positions understand the needs of the people around them.
