- 2) To provide a platform to engage in face-to-face dialogue with FDA and establish contacts in an effort to improve proactive, voluntary compliance with regulatory requirements.

The target audience for this training is the pharmaceutical industry in the District area, which includes Alabama, Louisiana, Mississippi, and Tennessee; however, the training will be open to any participants who register to attend. The objective is to increase voluntary compliance and promote the manufacturing and processing of safe product; thus, enhancing the protection of the public health and use resources wisely.
