### STATEMENT OF EDUCATIONAL NEED

To serve as a preceptor of pharmacy interns/externs, a pharmacist must be duly licensed and meet requirements as established by the state board of pharmacy. The requirements necessitated by the Alabama Board of Pharmacy (ALBOP) includes specialized training and continual education on best practices for pharmacy preceptors. The purpose of the activity is providing the participant with the specialized training/education needed to serve in this important role. Speakers will provide an active learning environment that facilitates understanding of the ALBOP regulations related to preceptors. Tools to enhance the educational experience of experiential pharmacy students will also be shared.

**This is a knowledge-based CPE activity appropriate for all pharmacists and is registered with the Alabama State Board of Pharmacy for preceptor continuing education hours for both the initial and renewal preceptor training for the 2025–2026 renewal period.** To receive credit, participants must attend the entire session and complete program assessments.
