Applicants with an associate of arts or an associate of science from an Alabama community college will be able to use their degree to satisfy all general education requirements for the program. Regardless of how many credits were earned during the course of the two-year degree, students will still be required to complete 68 credit hours for the award of their baccalaureate degree from Samford University.

The goal of the Bachelor of Arts degree with a major in Organizational Leadership is to provide students with the skills and knowledge to perform as effective leaders within their organizations and society.
