Say:

- The Psalms are the songbook of the Bible. We love the Psalms and use them a lot to offer praise to God and encourage worship.
- But, two thirds of the psalms are songs of lament, which the psalmist is tell God that *not all is right with the world,* that *bad things are happening,* and that *he doesn't see what God is up to.*
- Lament or being honest about our grief and questions in front of God is an important part of our discipleship.
- We often try to avoid lament rush past sadness, ignore grief, and silence questions.
- Today, we're going to come face to face with that, and use it to push us to intercede for others.
- We're going to do that in silence, so starting now let's not talk until we're done.
- Distribute the newspaper front pages. Because of the resolution of the images, most of the body text is obscured, which is a good thing.

Say:

- As I hand you a front page from a newspaper, take a few moments to look at it.
- Pause for 30 seconds once they are all distributed.
- What images do you see? *Pause*
- What words do you read? Pause
- Notice how you feel as you look and read. Pause

Say:

- We're going to use these newspapers as a way to intercede or pray on behalf of others.
- Keep your eyes open as you pray silently. I will guide us through.
- This is a sacred moment, so let's continue to not talk.

Pray:

- God, we look at the words and images in front of us, and struggle to know how to pray. Help us now.
- Tell God about the things you see and read that upset you that make you angry, sad, or confused.
- Look an an image on your newspaper. Pray for that person, their family, and friends. Let the Holy Spirit help you know what to pray for.
- Find a word on your newspaper that stands out to you. Offer that word to God, and ask that God be present in the midst of it.
- Look at the entire front page, and ask that God would give the leaders of our communities, churches, and country wisdom to know how to address these things effectively.
- Ask God to redeem this tragedy for his glory.
- God, we lift all those impacted by this tragedy to you, and ask that you'd comfort those hurting and mourning. Amen.

Say:

- Please pass the newspapers in and leave them here.
- As you go through your week, these images and words may come time mind. That's the Holy Spirit inviting you to pray.
- If you have questions or want to talk afterward, I'll be around.

"I just kept binking to myself. This isn't real. This is not happening. This is not real." Lisa Schau, of Sacramenta, told the Las Vegos Reviers-Journal near the scene. "I just kept thinking that over and over. And it was."

And it was."

But the staggering camage — at least 59 dead and 527 injured — beought out the best in Las Vegas Valley residents. They rushed to help the wounded; denated blood, supplies and money; and prayed on masse for victims and their lamilies.



At least 59 people were killed and 527 others injured after a gunman opened fire Sunday night at an outdoor country music festival near the Las Vegas Strip - the deadliest mass shooting in modern American history.

The scene: The first shots came at 10:08 p.m., about 20 minutes into a performance by country star Jason Aldean. More than 22,000 concert-goers sought cover as a barrage of bullets ripped through the crowd, fired from a room on the 32nd floor of the Mandalay Bay hotel across the street.

The gunmans Police said the suspect, 64-year-old Stephen Paddock, a resident of Mesquite, Nevada, had smashed the windows with a hammer-like tool before opening fire. By the time a SWAT team burst into the room, Paddock had killed himself. He was described as a highstakes gambler who "kept to himself" before the massacre.

The weapons: The hotel room contained at least 23 weapons, mostly military-style rifles. A total of 19 more weap ons were found in Paddock's car and in his home.

The threat: "Right now we believe it's a solo act, a lone wolf attacker," Clark County Sheriff Joe Lombardo said. Federal homeland officials said there were no specific. credible threats to other public venues around the country.

The response: "It was an act of pure evil," President Donald Trump said in a televised statement, adding that he would travel to Las Vegas on Wednesday. - Les Angeles Times


